Corporate Member

Regular Member

Dues: \$115 Includes print and online issues of the *Bulletin* and *ceramic-SOURCE* buyers guide; online membership directory; and free on-line access to the peer-reviewed *Journal of the American Ceramic Society* and the *Inter-national Journal of Applied Ceramic Technology*. Discount registration fees to all Society sponsored and co-sponsored meetings, including the ACerS 111th Annual Meeting combined with Materials Science and Technology Conference and Exhibition (Pittsburch, PA, Oct. 25–29, 2009).

Associate Member

Dues: complimentary for first year; \$40 for second year. Students who have just graduated receive a free 12-month Associate Membership upon completion of education. In the second year, Associate Membership dues are \$40. Associate members become Individual members in their third year.

Retired Member

Dues: \$65 If you are 60 years or older, have five (5) or more years of continuous membership in ACerS, and are retired, you qualify for the Retired membership level. Contact customer service if you meet all criteria for Retired membership.

Senior Member

Dues: \$40 If you are 60 years or older, have twenty-five (25) or more years of continuous membership in ACerS, and are retired, you qualify for the Senior membership level. Contact customer service if you meet all criteria for Senior membership.

Emeritus Member

Dues: exempt from dues. If you are 65 years or older and have thirty-five (35) or more years of continuous membership, you qualify for Emeritus membership. Contact customer service if you meet both criteria for Emeritus membership.

Gap Coverage

Dues: waived for up to 12 months. ACerS offers free gap coverage for members who have been laid-off or lost their job. Current members who are up for renewal, or members whose membership has expired within the past 6 months and who are unemployed, are eligible for 6 months free membership. At the end of 6 months, you can sign up for another 6 months free membership upon request if you are still unemployed. Contact customer service if you would like to request a waiver of dues.

Dues: \$300 - (Small) Companies with 50 employees or less. Includes two

individual memberships. **Dues: \$950 – (Large)** Companies with 51 or more employees. Includes six individual memberships.
