TOUR DETAILS, TERMS, AND CONDITIONS

MS&T15 Registrations: All tour registrants <u>must register and attend</u> MS&T15. Registration, travel and hotel reservations for MS&T15 are the responsibility of the individual student.

Tour Boarding and Departure: Tour departs from the Greater Columbus Convention Center. Tour participants must meet at 12:00 p.m. to board the bus. Boarding location to be determined. The bus departs **promptly** at 12:30 p.m. The bus will arrive at Allied Mineral Products at 1:00 p.m., and the return bus to the convention center will be back no later than 5 p.m.
