Tour Details, Terms, and Conditions:

Conference registration: All tour registrants must be registered to attend MS&T 2018. Registration, travel and hotel reservations for the MS&T 2018 conference are the responsibility of the individual student.

Boarding and Departure: The tour will depart from the Greater Columbus Convention Center. Tour participants must meet at 11:45 a.m. to check-in and board the bus. The boarding location is to be determined and will be communicated to all registered participants. Lunch will NOT be provided prior to boarding the bus. It is recommended that attendees arrange their own lunch plans prior to arriving for check-in and boarding the bus. The bus will depart promptly at 12:00 p.m. The return bus to the convention center will be back no later than 5:00 p.m.

Dress code: Please keep in mind that you will be entering a professional work environment and appropriate business casual attire is required. Attendees should wear closed toe shoes that fully cover the foot and have a maximum 1 inch heel. Long pants and long sleeves are also required.

Cameras and cell phones: There is no camera use allowed on site. Cell phone use is not permitted while the tour is taking place.

Safety information: Site emergency number is “660”. Dial to report medical emergency, chemical spill, or any other type of emergency. Report all injuries, possible injuries or near misses using the “660” number. **Building evacuation alarm is a continuous buzzer tone.** If the evacuation alarm sounds, you must leave the building via the nearest exit. **Tornado warning alarm is a “whoop-whoop” tone.** If the tornado alarm sounds, you must follow posted signs and/or other workers to shelter area.

No alcohol or weapons (including concealed carry) may be brought on site. All forms of tobacco use is banned on site, indoors and out.
