Nomination Form

Rules:

1. An individual or group may nominate one or more candidates who shall be members of the Society at the time of nomination.
2. Nominations must be returned no later than **January 15**, to the Robert B. Sosman Award Committee, c/o The American Ceramic Society, 550 Polaris Parkway, Suite 510, Westerville, OH 43082 or by email to ezimmerman@ceramics.org.
3. Selection of an awardee will be based on the nomination and accompanying evidence that describe the nominee's substantial impact in the field of ceramics science.
4. The unsuccessful nominees shall constitute an active list and shall be considered for 3 consecutive years. Updated information regarding the nominees will be accepted for subsequent judging.

Purpose: To honor the late Dr. Robert B. Sosman by recognizing a scientist whose impact in the field of ceramic science warrants the highest level of recognition for scientific accomplishment awarded by the Basic Science Division of the American Ceramic Society.

The winner will present the honorary Sosman Lecture at the Annual Meeting of the Ceramic Society during the year for which the award is given. Nominations received by January 15, 200x are considered for awards to be given in 200x+1, 200x+2, and 200x+3.
