New Initiatives/Opportunities:

ECD reinvigorated the International Committee with the appointment of new chair/members, and a kick-off meeting (call) to establish expectation and deliverables. The (2014-2016) ECD International Committee is chaired by Hisayuki Suematsu (Japan) and supported by the following members: Eva Hemmer (Canada), Marlies Van Bael (Belgium), Taejin Hwang (Korea) and Shaoming Dong (China).

Global Young Investigators Forum: Continue looking for funding/financial support to increase participation of young leaders, including undergraduate and graduate students, for the 39th ICACC (Jan. 2015).

40th **ICACC celebration at 2016 Daytona Beach Conference**: Sub-committees have been formed with volunteers to lead planning and execution. Work in progress includes (1) Fund-raising, (2) 40th Jubilee Commemorative Book, special ed. of publications contributed by past ECD awardees and Chairs, and (3) Event planning.

Action Items for ACerS Board Consideration at October 11, 2014 meeting: NONE

Issues/Concerns:

We observe downward trend in participation of Global Young Investigator (GYI) Forum since the inception in the 2012 ICACC, which was established with specific goals. The 1st GYI Award initiative (in 2014 ICACC) provided a boost in visibility of the forum though the overall sustainable participation is yet to be demonstrated. (*For 2015 ICACC we may see a potential turn-around evidenced by a substantial increase in abstract submissions. In the meantime the ECD Executive & Award Committee continues to receive high interest and substantial numbers of nominees for the GYI Award).* We hope to achieve more inter-divisional participation in GYIF, and seek support from other division leaders by encouraging related individuals to participate and lead.
