Global Engagement in Ceramic Science and Technology (GECST) Program

We have proudly launched this program to encourage, develop, and promote students and young professionals in the field of ceramic science and technology through their active involvement and participation in ECD of ACerS. This program will also develop and foster cooperation among young professionals from different parts of the world. The programs sponsor the ACerS's Global Graduate Researchers Network (GGRN) Membership while encouraging an equal number of student sponsorships by Professors/Universities (allowing multi-year registration). During the period from Oct. 2015 to August 2016, about 110 new GGRN members have joined ECD, with nearly 200 member-years, through this program. (We acknowledge Manabu Fukushima's highly dedicated work for this program.)

ECD has 2,361 members as of August 31, 2016.
