- Meeting funding agency requirements for publication in Gold OA journals
- Topics outside of the scope of ACT
- Engineering and science advances at all stages of ceramic and glass research and application, including the reporting of interim findings or “work in progress”

The American Ceramic Society and Wiley are teaming up to underwrite a significant portion of the IJCES OA article processing charges (APCs)*. The authors of the first 25 conference report manuscripts from ICACC accepted into IJCES this year will have their APCs reduced to \$100. The next 20 manuscripts will have 50% of their APCs waived.
