Frequently Asked Questions for Virtual ICACC 2021

Oral Presentations

Which sessions will be run as live vs. on-demand? Please check the Proposed Schedule link (sidebar of website) for the daily schedule.

What is the format for oral presentations? All oral presentations must be recorded in advance, either on the Bravura platform or on your own Zoom platform. Files must be submitted as MP4 file format and cannot exceed 500 MB. More information is available in the Virtual Speaker Guide, available from the Bravura speaker portal when it opens.

What are the time constraints for presentations? In general, contributed presentations should last 20 minutes. Invited speakers are allowed 30 minutes. Please do not extend your presentation beyond your assigned duration/time.

How do I record the presentation? Information is available in the Virtual Speaker Guide.

How do I submit my recorded oral presentation? When the Bravura platform opens, the Presenters Toolbox (linked in the website sidebar) will list the speaker portal URL and speaker password to record or upload your presentation. Information for the recording process is available in the Virtual Speaker Guide.

By what date do I upload my presentation online? You must know the symposium number your abstract is accepted under (see acceptance email). See the deadline dates at the end of this document.

How do I avoid having people save/record my presentations? Similar to the inperson conference, during the registration process, all attendees are asked to agree to not save or record presentations from the conference. In addition, attendees are not able to record someone else's presentation while watching presentations in the Bravura system.

Poster Presentations

What is the format for poster presentations? Presenters should provide the poster in PDF format. Note that graphics should be simple, colorful, well-labeled, and clear. Poster presenters can also create a 2-minute video to introduce their poster.

How do I submit my poster presentation? Posters are uploaded as a PDF. More

information is available in the Virtual Speaker Guide.

By what date do I upload my poster presentation online? You must know the symposium number your poster is accepted under (see acceptance email). Check the deadline dates at the end of this document.

Time Zone Considerations

In which time zone will ICACC'21 Virtual take place? All presentations and events will be scheduled in Eastern Standard Time (GMT -5). NOTE: When speakers are logged in, the Bravura speaker console displays the session time and presentation time in the speaker's home time zone.

Registration

I am a presenter – do I need to register and pay? Yes, you must pay the registration fee to participate in the conference. The early-bird registration deadline is **January 8.**
