





## The Joint International Conference on Applied Physics and Materials Applications & Applied Magnetism and Ferroelectrics (ICAPMA-JMAG-2021)

December 1st – 4th, 2021 at Nongnooch Pattaya Garden & Resort, Thailand Hosted by ACerS-Thailand Chapter and IEEE MagSoc Thailand Chapter

**ICAPMA-JMAG-2021** was successfully held at Nongnooch Pattaya Garden & Resort in a hybrid format.
