Applicants will be required to be sponsored by an active member of the Southwest Section of The American Ceramic Society.

SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS ARE MADE USING THE FOLLOWING PRIORITIES:

- 1. Evidence of dedication to ceramic sciences and/or the ceramic industry in general
- 2. Sponsorship or recommendation by an active member of the Southwest Section of ACerS
- 3. Scholastic record.
- 4. Financial need
- 5. Well-rounded personal character
- 6. Should more than one applicant be deemed equally eligible, the permanent resident of the Southwest Section (AR, KA, LA, OK, TX, MS, AL, GA, TN, NC, SC and the border states of Mexico) will be selected.
- 7. Interest in industries relevant to the Southwest Section
