

along with Mr. A. H. Baker's committee, would be interested in the ASHV work on glass. On the suggestion of Chairman Ghering, Mr. Miller agreed to write a letter of information on this subject to both Mr. Baker and Mr. Sharp for distribution to the members of their sub-committees.

New Business:

Mr. Gilbert (by letter) suggested that C-14 designate a representative who would be responsible for liaison with the Packaging Institute. The chairman referred this matter to K. C. Lyon for consideration.

The secretary called attention to a change in voting requirements of the Society. The modification "places a further limitation on the vote so that no recommendation will be approved that meets with the objection of more than one third of either the producers or consumers". (Letter to Chairmen of Technical Committees, May 8, 1950, Circular No. 79).

Mr. P. J. Smith, Secretary, Committee E-1, has informed our committee (by letter) of the reactivation of work on Elastic Strength of Materials (Subcommittee 3 of E-1) and invites representation from other ASTM Technical Committees that have interest in this subject. Mr. Smith's communication was referred to Dr. J. T. Littleton for consideration.

The meeting was adjourned at 12 o'clock, midnight.
